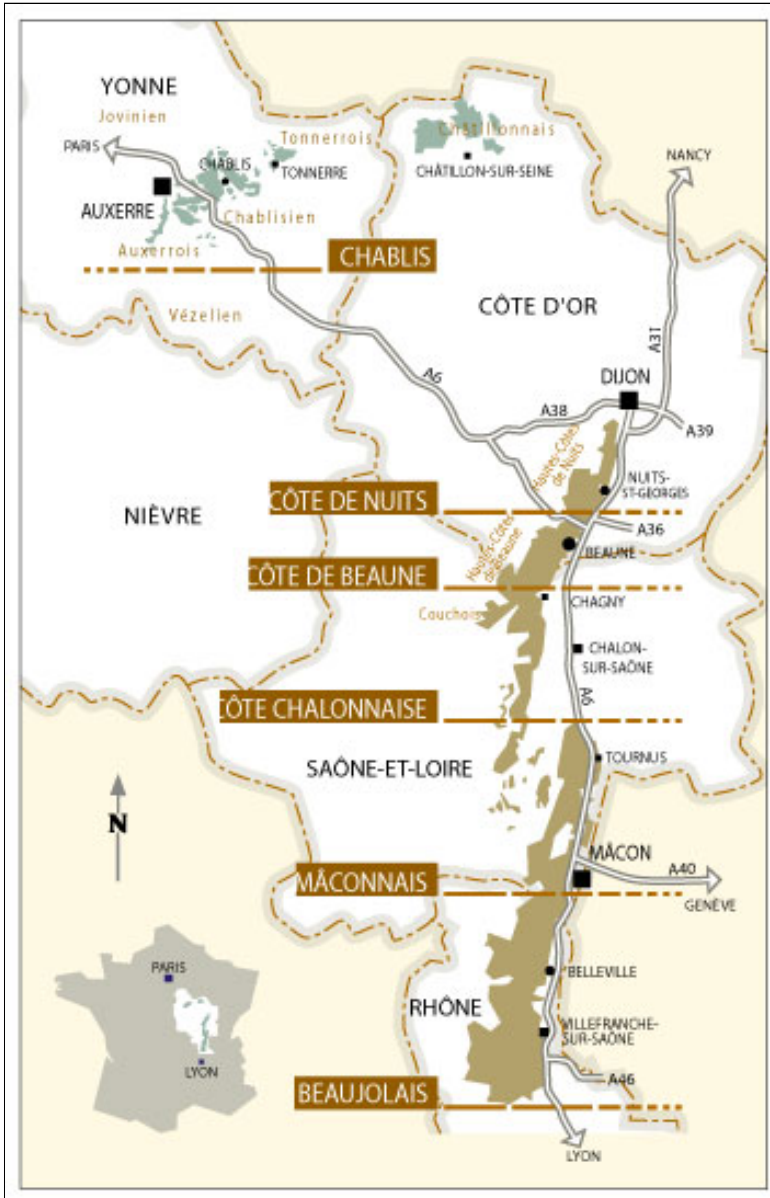

LOCATION

This rosé wine of Burgundy originates from both Beaujolais and Burgundy. It is a wine produced on two different types of soils: granit for Beaujolais and clay/limestone for the northern part of Burgundy.

VINEYARD INFORMATION

The Coteaux Bourguignons regional appellation is rather new, it was created in 2011.

VINIFICATION AND MATURATION

Grapes are destemmed and macerate a short time in order to get a light pink colour. This wine stays then in stainless steel tanks before bottling.
